

We typically stage two productions annually at Caerwys Town Hall, with rehearsals commencing months in advance. We welcome members of all experience levels and are always open to new members.

In recent times, ABC Dramatics has been rebuilding following the challenges posed by lockdowns. The society has demonstrated resilience by regrouping and planning new performances. "Beyond a Joke," is the third play in recent years and follows two sellout plays; Fairway to Heaven and The Lady Vanishes. This is the first time we have performed in the wonderful Theatr Twm o'r Nant and the society are grateful for this opportunity and for the generous support of Denbigh Phoenix Players in making this possible.
